

2024 Global Korea Scholarship (Graduate Program)

Program Objective

The Korean Government Scholarship Program is designed to provide higher education in Korea for international students with the aim of promoting international exchange in education, as well as mutual friendship amongst the participating countries.

Eligibility

- The applicant and his/her parents must have foreign citizenships. And all applicants must hold citizenship of NIIED designated countries that are invited to take part in the GKS program.
 * Applicants who hold Korean citizenship are not permitted to apply for this program.
- 2. Applicants must be under 40 years of age as of Sep. 1st, 2024 (born after Sep. 1st, 1984).
- **3.** Applicants must hold a Bachelor's (For Master's program) or Master's degree (For the Doctoral program) or a diploma that is equivalent as of July 31st 2024.
- An applicants who have completed a degree in Korea are not eligible to apply.
 (*Exception: Overseas Korean Adoptees and GKS scholars)
- **5.** Applicants must maintain a grade point average (G.P.A.) of at least 2.64 on a 4.0 scale, 2.80 on a 4.3 scale, 2.91 on a 4.5 scale, or grades/marks/score of 80% or higher from the previously attended institution.

Selection Procedure

<u>**1**st Selection</u>: Each 1st selection institution (Korean Embassies or designated universities) will select and recommend the best applicants according to its respective standards.

<u>**2**nd Selection</u>: The NIIED Selection Committee will select the most successful candidates from the pool of applicants recommended by the 1st selection institutions. Applicants who were recommended by a designated university will automatically be granted admission to the university that recommended them, upon the condition they are selected as a successful candidate in the 2^{nd} Selection.

<u> 3^{rd} </u> Selection: Only the candidates who were recommended by a Korean embassy and passed the 2nd selection successfully will be evaluated for admission by the 3 universities to which they applied; each candidate has to gain admission from at least one university.

Scholarship

1. Duration of Scholarship:

- Master's (01.09.2024 ~ 31.08.2027) : 1 yr. of Korean language + 2 yrs of Master program
- > Doctoral(01.09.2024 ~ 31.08.2028) : 1 yr. of Korean language + 3 yrs of Doctoral program

✤ NOTE!

- After the Korean language course, the scholarship period of degree course can not be extended beyond the designated duration.
- In the case that a scholar possesses a TOPIK Level 5 or 6, he or she must be exempted from the Korean language course and must start his/her academic course of Master or Doctoral.

All documents including transcript, self-introduction, study plan, certificate of language proficiency (Korean and English), recommendations, published papers and awards, etc., will be evaluated

Required Documents

1. Required Documents: One original document (Copied documents could not accepted)

2. Documents not in English or Korean must be accompanied by a complete English or Korean translation authenticated by the issuing institution or notarized by a notary's office.

Important Notes

- Dual applications are not accepted. Applicants must apply for this program via only one institution.
- Documents should be presented in their original form.
- Submitted documents will not be returned to the applicants.
- The "Required certificates" must be submitted with an apostille or consular confirmation. Original documents without additional authentication, notarized documents certified by only a notary public, or certified documents confirmed by the other government agencies will not be accepted. (Exception: certificate issued by Korean government or institutions should be submitted in their original version without additional authentication.)
- Incomplete or incorrect documents may lead to application rejection or failure in the Selection Committee, and scholarship revocation even after entry into Korea.
- Applicants must accurately complete the health checklist truthfully. All successful candidates must take a comprehensive medical exam when its' orientation. The candidates who are judged to be physically unfit for this program will not be accepted.
- Transferring to a different university and different department after confirming the host university is not permitted in any cases

Accommodation

- 1. Priority to enter on-campus residence halls are given to GKS scholars and the university supports 50% of dormitory maintenance fee.
- 2. Facilities in the residence halls: internet zone, study room, praying room, laundry room, fitness center, table tennis courts, multi-purpose outdoor playground for soccer and basketball, etc.

3. Discounted Dormitory Fees (for GKS Scholars)

1. Campus Facilities

- 1) International lounge where international students can participate in inter-cultural events and meet new friends.
- 2) Meditation room (Praying room)
- 3) Korean Language Institute, Dongsan Library, Hengso Museum, Keimyung Art Center, Keimyung Hankakchon (Korean cultural village) and an on-campus clinic
- 4) Reading room for graduate students

2. Cultural Programs for International Students

- 1) Field trip to historical sites held once a semester
- 2) Korean Cultural Experience class held once a week: tea ceremony, calligraphy, craft, etc.
- 3) International students' festival, temple stay, etc.

3. Counseling Service

- 1) Monthly counseling session
- 2) Orientation for new students: academic matters, campus life, visas, extracurricular programs for international students, etc.
